Dear Parents/Carers,

I have been notified by the National Education Union that their members are planning to take further industrial action. The industrial action is connected to a dispute with the National Government and is in no way connected to Redhill or our trust.

The two days announced for further industrial action are Thursday 27th April and Tuesday 2nd May.

I am really sorry to write to you with regards to further industrial action. I know the impact that this has on you son/daughters' education, and we never take any decision lightly.

Year 10 students are scheduled to be in their examinations on these two days. At Redhill we run and supervise the Year 10 examinations in exactly the same way we deliver the real GCSE examinations. We hire invigilators who are trained for this job.

We expect all Year 10 students to come into school on the days below for their examinations. The timings of these are below. You will notice that we have changed the timings of the English and Science Examinations, this is to help the day run smoothly.

The exam timings will be as follows:

Thursday 27th April

Combined and Triple Science - Start Time 08:40. End Time 09:40. Extra Time 09:55

English Literature Paper 2 - Start Time 10:25. End Time 12:10. Extra Time 12.36

On this day we will supervise the students between their examinations, students will return home after their English exam.

Maths Paper 1 Non Calculator - Start Time 08:40. End Time 09:40. Extra Time 09:55


Geography Paper 2 - Start Time 10:25. End Time 11:10. Extra Time 11:21
