Dear Parents/Carers

I have been notified by the National Education Union that their members are planning to take further industrial action. The industrial action is connected to a dispute with the National Government and is in no way connected to Redhill or our Trust.

The two days announced for further industrial action are Wednesday 5th and Friday 7th of July.

I am really sorry to write to you with regards to further industrial action. I know the impact that this has on you son/daughters' education and we never take any decision lightly.

The 5th July is one of our pre-planned Year 6 induction days. As you can imagine a huge amount of planning has gone into this day and rearranging it at this late stage will be very difficult. We are planning to go ahead with this day as it is an important part of the transition from Year 6 into Year 7.

With this in mind, I have carried out my risk assessment and I am unable to open the school for Years 7,8, 9 & 10 on the 5th July. We will provide work via our Google classroom and live interactions will be available from those members of staff who remain in school.

My risk assessment allows for Year 10 to come into school on Friday 7th July. Unfortunately, we will not be able to accommodate any other year groups on this date. Therefore, work for years 7,8 & 9 will be online from those members of staff who are in school.

I apologise for the inconvenience that this will cause. Please be reassured that we will adapt our lessons and use extended learning to catch up on any missed curriculum content. I hope that this will be the last of the industrial action for this academic year.
