THINGS TO DO

- Research a range of careers and post 16 courses or apprenticeships. Find out what qualifications and grades they require.
- Read all the information provided carefully and think about which subjects interest

you.

- Find out what educational routes are expected for that career path. For instance, is a specific degree course or particular subjects at A level required? What GCSE grades are needed to get you onto the A level course or apprenticeship? What work experience will help you get onto the course or into a job?
- Use the national careers service website to find out about careers <u>https://nationalcareersservice.direct.gov.uk</u>
- Talk to your parents, tutor, teachers and older students. Spend lots of time on this it's important that you get it right.
