Dear Parents/Carers,

I am delighted that, following the application process, we have been able to offer your child a place at Redhill School in September. I am sure you are already aware of the importance that we place on building a partnership between the school and home and we are looking forward to working with you in the coming months and years.

At Redhill School, our aim is for every pupil to succeed academically and to develop the character and virtues that will enable them to flourish. We recognise the unique needs and aspirations of each of our pupils to ensure that they enjoy school and achieve their full potential. Successful transition is clearly key to this and, at Redhill School, we do all we can to ensure that the process runs as smoothly as possible.

Please note the following outline of our key dates and events for transition:

1. Over the coming weeks, we will visit all our feeder primary schools to talk to the children who will be joining us in September.
2. In addition to these visits, we will be meeting with Year 6 teachers to share relevant information about our new intake.
3. **PARENTS' EVENING – TUESDAY 2nd JULY at 6pm in the main Hall.** This meeting will last for approximately 1 hour and will provide important information. It will also be an opportunity to meet key staff. We look forward to meeting you on that evening. We must stress that this evening is for parents only and we regret that it will not be possible to accommodate children.
4. **WEDNESDAY, 3rd JULY AND THURSDAY, 4<sup>TH</sup> JULY.** Your child will be able to spend two days with us in school. Pupils will be given the opportunity to look around the school and to meet fellow pupils and members of staff, as well as sampling some lessons. We hope that this will give the children a useful introduction to life at Redhill, ease any worries they might have and enable them to settle down very quickly in September.

Further details of both the above events will follow in the induction packs that you and your child will receive.

It would be most helpful if parents could come on the dates stated, as staff will only be available to sell uniform at those dates/times.


