

Dear Parent/Carer

I am writing regarding school PE kit and the high standards that we expect of all of our pupils at Redhill School. It is vital that students are fully equipped for lessons and as a PE department we feel that it is essential that students are safe, feel comfortable and that this develops a positive learning environment in lessons. We also see value in an approach where all of the kit worn by students is uniformed and consistent across all lessons.

There is a full list of Redhill branded PE kit which is compulsory for students along with items that are optional. Unbranded PE kit cannot be worn in place of this. PE kit items can be found on our website in the school uniform and equipment section. Kit can be purchased from Totally Uniform.

Could you please ensure that your child has full correct Redhill PE kit for the start of the new academic year in September. If you are choosing not to have initials on your child's kit could you please have some form of identification in their kit in case it is lost or left around school.

Please can I also take this opportunity to remind you that if your child is unable to take part in a PE lesson we ask that they bring a note explaining their injury or illness <u>as well as their full PE kit</u>. This is our policy and if your son/daughter is injured then they can still play a part in lessons, we will not expect them to complete any strenuous activity. This helps to maintain the high standards of appearance, engagement and behaviour that we expect within the PE Department at Redhill School.

I hope that you will continue to support the PE department in providing your child with kit that will make them look smart and feel comfortable when participating in lessons and extra-curricular activities.
